QUARANTINE ART FAIR IS A COVIDSAFE EVENT

The COVID-19 pandemic has changed the way in which we must plan and run events. Event organisers have a duty of care towards our attendees, staff and volunteers and as such have considered the risks associated with hosting an event and the transmission of COVID-19.

Quarantine Art Fair intend to deliver a COVID-Safe event in accordance with the current restrictions, while also ensuring that the public feel confident to attend and that staff and volunteers work in a safe environment.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING QUEUE AND CROWD MANAGEMENT

- There will be 4 square metres of available floor space per person within the exhibition spaces and the maintaining of a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres from others will be ensured.
- Queues will be marked clearly with visible standing spots for attendees, and the use of bollards, temporary fencing and decals.
- The number of attendees permitted as per current Victorian Government restrictions in place at the time of the event will be managed via a scheduled ticketing system
- Crowd numbers outdoors will be managed by security services.

HYGIENE AND SANITATION

- The sanitisation of heavily used areas will be managed by designated staff members during the event.
- All points of sale will be cashless.
- Alcohol based hand sanitizer stations will be located throughout the event site with clear signage of where to find them.
- There will be hand washing stations in the bathrooms stocked with soap, warm water and paper towels.

STAFF

- Event staff will maintain physical distance from attendees and follow mask wearing requirements.
- Event staff and volunteers will be trained on how to monitor and control measures.
- Sanitation practices will be incorporated for shared tools and/or equipment.

COMMUNICATION AND SIGNAGE

- All event communication pre, during and post the event via social media and the website, and all event signage will ensure that event attendees understand their responsibilities and know what measures they need to take care to keep themselves and others safe.
- There is a plan in place if an attendee becomes ill during the event.
- Signage will be located throughout the event site and work areas to remind everyone of physical distancing and hygiene measures.
- All attendees and staff are encouraged to download the Federal Government COVID Safe mobile app.

SITE CONTROLS

- Contact information of all attendees will be gathered and managed via an app to facilitate contact tracing.
- The bump in and bump out schedule will stagger contractors, staff, and volunteers to minimize crossover.
- The site will be sanitised once bump in is complete, and prior to event attendees arriving.
- A security service will control the access to ensure the number of attendees doesn't exceed the allowed one under State Government's restrictions.

FOOD AND DRINKS

- All event food and beverage vendors will follow WorkSafe Guidelines and the Food Safety Standards.

POST - EVENT CONTROLS

- Attendees can report a positive case to the Fair Directors and we will use the registration information to contact trace and inform all attendees.
