TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Ticket Holders will be eligible for a full refund if they cancel or change their ticket 48hrs prior to their attendance time slot. If any Ticket Holder cancels or changes their ticket within the 48hrs prior to their booking they will not receive any refund or compensation.

Pets or domestic animals are not allowed in Point Nepean National Park at any time. Guide dogs are excepted.

Any Ticket Holder who is behaving in an intoxicated, disorderly, aggressive or any other antisocial manner will be asked to leave by Quarantine Art Fair security. Quarantine Art Fair reserves the right to refuse entry to Ticket Holders if their behaviour is deemed unacceptable.

COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR TICKET HOLDERS

If you, or someone you have had close contact with, is awaiting COVID-19 test results, has COVID-19, is suspected of having COVID-19, has been overseas in the last 14 days, or has been required to self-isolate for any other reason, you must not attend the Fair.

If you have COVID-19 symptoms or feel unwell we ask that you do not attend the Fair.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Quarantine Art Fair is entitled, in the case of compelling reasons or reasons beyond its control, to postpone, cancel, shorten, or extend the Fair without liability or obligation to any Ticket Holder.

Quarantine Art Fair reserves the right to make changes to the format and the content of the Fair and will not be liable to any Ticket Holder for any loss or damage (including indirect or consequential damage) suffered as a result or arising from or in any way connected to cancellation, postponement or change to the Fair.

Quarantine Art Fair will refund payments (less an administration fee of 10%) made by Ticket Holders for Tickets only if the entire Fair is cancelled and cannot be rescheduled or replaced with an alternative offering due to a Force Majeure Event, including if the Fair is cancelled due to COVID-19 by federal, state or local health authorities.
